

## NEW NORWAY SCHOOL – 2019-2020 Supply List

Agendas will be provided for students in Grades ECS to 6. The fee for the Agenda will be added to your school bill.

Other fees such as instrument rentals, High School Student Union fees, options fees, field trip and student activity fees, and athletic participation fees for extra-curricular sports teams, will be charged over and above these rates. Fee Invoices will be sent home with students in the first few weeks of the school year; please monitor online fee program.

Pupil supplies such as pencils, pens, erasers, glue, scribblers, loose leaf, binders, geometry sets, paints and crayons, and as listed below are to be supplied by the parents. All junior high students are required to have a dictionary or "app". All supplies should be brought to the school so that they are readily available to the students as they are required.

In order to keep our school clean, all students are asked to have 2 pairs of shoes - one pair that they can wear inside the school and one pair that they wear outside. Please label all footwear with permanent marker.

### **Junior & Senior High** students need a similar

list to the Grade 6's including binders, paper and/or exercise books, lots of pens & pencils, erasers, white glue AND glue sticks, scissors, exercise books, dictionary (whether book or app), ruler, good-quality math/geometry set, pencil crayons & duo tangs. They will require earbuds or headphones for use with the computers.  
Junior High students require a scientific calculator (not "graphing")  
Grade 10 and 11 will need a graphing calculator TI-83 plus, TI-84 plus or TIInspire CX are recommended. For a full list of acceptable calculators see Mrs. Shostak. As well, students must provide their own replacement batteries, if applicable.  
Grade 8 and 9's will need at least one notebook that has between 80-200 pages and is close to 8 ½ by 11 as possible, for Math. (Fivestar are excellent)  
Junior High and Senior High students are encouraged to have an agenda, to build life-long organizational skills. The school will not provide them (to allow our older students to express their individuality), but teachers will be using them as part of their classroom management.
